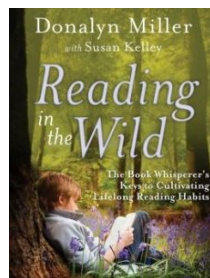


Reading in the Wild

Donalyn Miller speaks to LCN

Reading in the Wild is based on survey data from 900 adult readers and assessments from the author's middle school students. Donalyn Miller identifies the characteristics of "wild" readers and shares methods that support students' development into lifelong readers. During this workshop, attendees will reflect on their reading lives, discuss the classroom, library, and home conditions that foster "wild" reading, and examine texts and tools that engage young readers and move them toward independent reading lives. This session will build on the expertise represented in the Literacy Coaching Network.
